## In Research Of...

### Objectives

- In this class research lesson, students will use the internet to find quotes that relate to their chosen letter.
- Students learn to use their time on the internet properly.

### Materials

- Any list or book of quotations such as *Bartlett's Famous Quotations* or *A World of Words: An ABC of Quotations*
- Computer with internet access
- Pencil
- Paper

### Lesson Plan

- 1 Give each student a letter from A-Z. (If there are less than 26 students, leave out letters such as x, q, z, v; If there is more than 26, double up on letters)
- 2 Read the book and discuss how the quote relates to the letter.
- 3 Students have five minutes to look up famous, historical or important quotes.
- 4 Have students find quotes that they enjoy or think are important that use a word with their chosen letter. Students must have a real famous quote that goes with their letter.

- 5 Have the students write their letter, the quote and the author on their paper and share with the class.
- 6 Students take turns presenting to the class, explain who said the quote and why they picked the quote.
